## ISQ DARTFISH SYSTEMS

### ATTENTION COACHES AND CLUBS SKATERS

**Ice Skating Queensland has recently assembled two Dartfish systems, consisting of Laptop, Dartfish Software, DV Camera and Tripod. One system is located at each Iceworld Rink.**

**The systems are available for use by all ISQ coaches.**

**Coaches interested in using this innovative training system should arrange its use through the rink managers. There is no charge for the use of this equipment and it is expected that there be no additional charge passed on to skaters when the ISQ owned equipment is being used, although you may have to pay for his/her assistant's time.**

**Coaches using the ISQ Dart Fish systems are responsible for organising their own video assistants. Coaches should not interrupt other coaches conducting Dart Fish sessions which should be limited within a figure session to approximately 10 to 15 minutes where others may wish to utilise it.**

**Those coaches & parents who availed themselves of the Dartfish training arranged by ISQ last year, would be aware that the system can be setup for simple replay where the skater is videoed and the replay is available by the time they skate back to view, it is then reviewed and either saved or the next skater is videoed. It is also possible to upload video for review from a previous skating session.**

**Coaches should consider providing their own file storage equipment and we suggest an external hard drive or USB stick. Personal password protected files may be deleted without notice.**

**Coaches and Clubs may want to consider holding group lessons utilising Dart Fish.**

**Our Synchronized Skating Teams may also find it useful in some of their sessions.**

**The wireless network is disabled on the laptops and it is not to be enabled nor may the laptops be connected to the internet for any reason. We do not want it patched or upgraded via the internet as we are advised that our version has a number of features which disappear in the later versions.**

**Consideration should be given to coaches utilising & sharing across the sessions in a spirit of cooperation as would be expected with professional people.**

**Agreement should be reached on who will be responsible to secure the system at session’s end, where the system is being shared by a number of coaches and skaters, as would be expected.**

**The system is a useful tool to assist our skaters in their endeavours, recognising always that there is no magic bullet.**

**We would appreciate any feedback or suggestions to enhance the experience once the systems have been utilised for a while.**
