National Registration System

ISA is pleased to announce that the National Registration System, as approved by all members at the 2009 Annual General Meeting, will be launched online within the next few weeks.

National Registration is an effective tool for the Association to assist all States and Members with additional service and benefits.

The \$25 registration fee will also provide all State and Club members with insurance cover under the National Insurance Policy.

Only registered members will be covered under the insurance policy. This includes skaters, Council and Committee members, Technical Officials and all club members and volunteers.

Effective January 1st 2010, ISA will no longer be charging insurance to Clubs or State Associations as it will be paid directly by the participants via the National Registration System.

The Registration and Payment System selected by ISA is provided by SportingPulse www.sportingpulse.com.au and is used by many other Australian sporting organizations including the AFL and Hockey Australia. The ISA National Registration System will be easily accessible via the ISA website www.isa.org.au, registration is simple and the fee can be paid securely online via VISA, Mastercard or by Direct Credit through PayPal.

All members are responsible for registering themselves via the website. All registered participants will receive a unique registration number and password, allowing them to access and maintain their personal details and membership information.

Each State and Club will have their own secure access to the Registration System, allowing them access to the registration data provided by their members and to assist any members who may have difficulty with online access. ISA will provide training for up to two nominated representatives from each State and Club. Details of this training will be confirmed once the System is operational.
