- To allocate financial assistance to athletes, team members, judges, officials, coaches and team leaders attending local, intrastate events, interstate events, Australian Championships and international events.

ISQ recognises its reliance on Judges, Officials, Coaches & Team Leaders, to support and administer the sport locally, intrastate, interstate and internationally & financially supports those endeavours.

**Conditions:**

- (1) Recipients of the above assistance must be current financial members of ISQ Inc for at least second consecutive year.
- (2) Application for assistance [excl. entry fees] should be made upon return from the event & against original receipts for actual expenditure (GST receipts for all domestic exp). Application must be made on the ISQ Financial Assistance Application form available on the ISQ website or from the ISQ Administrator.
- (3) Only available to ISA and/or ISQ nominated/endorsed participants. Members should ensure that ISQ is aware of travel prior to travelling to events.
- (4) A maximum of two claims can be made per person per competition season. Any additional events may be considered under special application
- (5) One claim is only to be made when two competitions are attended within the one trip.
- (6) All claims must be made within 6 months of the final day of the relevant competition.
- (7) Travel must be from within Queensland or not more than 65 km outside the Queensland State Border.
