POLICY OBJECTIVE

To protect the interests of ISQ members, ISQ Inc and ISA Inc in possible breaches of ISU and ISA Rules.

To ensure that ISQ and its members comply with ISA policy.

To enable ISQ to discharge its responsibilities to effectively govern figure skating in Queensland.

POLICY

All skaters or synchronised skating teams wishing to participate in any competition outside of Queensland must be nominated or endorsed by Ice Skating Queensland Inc. (ISQ)

To qualify for nomination, the athletes must:

- (a) be a current financial members of ISQ;
- (b) be eligible to compete in the event (age, test level and / or previous competitions entered)
- (c) comply with all other ISQ and ISA Rules, communications and policies.

In the case of events with limited numbers of entries the athletes may also have to participate in selection trials that will determine the final nominations.

Even where the international competition or competition of another ISU Member which may not be an international competition does not require the national or state association to nominate entries, individual athletes and team applications to enter that particular event **must** be made through the ISQ, as ISQ must make the application through ISA.

Such applications must be made in advance by the athlete or team submitting their entry forms and payments made out to the competition organisers through the ISQ Sports Administrator.

REASONING

In order to discharge its governing responsibilities, ISQ must be formally advised of and approve the participation of Queensland skaters in any competitive events outside the State including overseas.
